











INCOME



Our total income for the year was \$94,368. Our largest source of income was reduced cost youth programs at \$65,440 and our second largest source of income was full priced adult programs at \$14,889.

EXPENSES



Our total expenses for the year were \$81,834. Our largest expense was stipends/transportation at \$44,381. Our second largest expense was administration costs at \$12,805.
